



What is An Angel Investor?




Terminology

Stage: Pre-seed, Seed, Series A (FFF = friends, family, fools; accredited investors may also participate in these rounds)

Forms of Financing: Equity, debt, convertible notes, SAFE

Valuation: Pre-Money, Post-Money

Priced Round: Equity-based investment round with a defined pre-money valuation, typically involving accredited investors who meet specific financial criteria



Typical Angel Deal

Raising Return \$1M or on exit less Early Pre-seed or Seed Valuation Angels expertise below & connects \$5M



Time Management

- 1. Increase Awareness: Document your time to look at days
- 2. Prioritize To Do List: Adjust priorities, dedicate time to most important items
- 3. Delegate More Effectively: Tracking time gives clarity to identify where / how to delegate better
- 4. Make Financial Decisions: Time is money. How long does something take = how much does it cost

Pie Chart of Your Life




